Business arising from the Minutes:

School BBQ

- Great turn out!
- Kathy reported positive feedback from other staff.
- Alicia pointed out it was difficult for the teachers to "meet and greet" when they were stuck barbequing. Also noted it is nice for kids to get to show parents their classroom/artwork which has been done in the past.
- Thoughts shared on doing the BBQ and an open house next year to give families a chance to tour the classrooms.
- Next year we would consider having parent volunteers and/or older students cook and serve so
 teachers would be free to mingle and be present in the classrooms. We could start open house
 at St. Columban with approx. times from 5-6 pm suggested them move to St. Patrick's for a BBQ
 starting at 5:30pm. Wrap up by 7:00 pm. Finishing the evening at St. Pat's allows for the school
 community to be gathered together as a whole.

Environmental Grant/Outdoor Learning Area

- TD grant was approved. We received \$5600.00
 \$1500.00 for picnic tables (CSAC had provided deposit of \$1300.00 to St. Mikes)
 \$ 300.00 for large chalk board
 \$500.00 for drawings /permits (this was paid for by school)
- Kristin and Dayna have each picked up one picnic table. Michelle or Kristin will contact Steve Manzo to arrange for pick up of last two tables when they are completed.

- Debbie Terpstra is donating soil and hopes to deliver this weekend. She is working with Mrs. Salter to order trees and bushes through connection that can order them at cost.
- Discussion was had over adding eavestrough to the north and south ends of the pavilion to protect run off into newly planted gardens. Downspouts could run off the back towards the fence.
- Dayna will get a quote from Dan Diehl and pass on the information via email for a final vote.
- Sharon's husband may be able to make the raised planter boxes or we could look at purchasing them? May be able to seek volunteers in the school community over the winter months for someone to make them?

St. Columban Sandbox

- Sharon reports the sandbox should come this week.
- Sand is being donated by the Noom Family.

Fundraising for Swings at St. Columban

- Fundraising letter will be sent home (hard copy) October 15 or 16th. Weekly reminders will be sent out in WAAG emails. Final reminder email November 1st. Fundraising campaign end date November 7/19.
- Michelle provided a draft of the letter for review.
- We would like to aim to get 4 swings, with option to purchase an additional accessible swing now or at a later time.
- Sharon reported that an example given to her was for 2 swings, base, ground prep and inspection for \$5000.00
- Sharon reported there is lots of room for the swings in the school yard. Locates would need to be obtained and the playground inspector would be able to tell us some options where they could be placed. They need to be on school property.
- Claire presented draft of fundraising letter to local community groups ie. K of C, CWL and St. Columban Soccer Club. Dayna had spoken with soccer club at a recent meeting and it sounds like they would be willing to make a contribution.
- Michelle mentioned we may also be able to explore applying for another grant.

Flip Give

- Jess passed on some information on Flip Give, an app that acts as a fundraiser while users are doing online shopping. Users would shop under St. Columban/St. Patrick's and a portion of money spent would come back to school. She is going to find out some more information on this and draft an announcement to attach to WAAG with information for school families.
- Monthly updates could be provided via WAG to show money raised using the app.
- Would be great to do around Christmas time when a lot of people will be online shopping.
- This could be considered our 2nd fundraiser.
